<u>Tournament Buy-In</u>: \$125.00 Advance Registration or, \$150 at the door <u>Optional add-on at the door</u>: \$25.00 for \$600 in chips

Each player will receive \$1,000.00 in Tournament Chips with their initial buy-in of \$125. Each player has the option of purchasing one (1) \$25.00 add-on at the door giving them an additional \$600.00. If a player falls below \$250 in chips during the first hour, after the hand has ended, they may do a re-buy of \$25.00 giving them an additional \$500 in Tournament Chips. A Player may do 2 rebuys at a time (MAX). And players may do unlimited re-buys in the first hour of play as long as they fall below \$250 in chips and the hand has ended or they are felted (no chips).

Blinds & Ante: First 4 rounds will be 20 minute rounds. After the break, rounds will be 15 minutes.

The Final 2 tables will continue with the above described blind format and there will be an additional ante from all players. Antes will start at \$100.00 per player and will increase each time the blinds go up in increments of \$100.00. The blinds will continue to increase each fifteen (15) minutes.

General Tournament Rules Will Apply:

- All players must be 18 years of age or older, ID required.
- If a card is accidentally exposed, that card will be 'burned', and new card will play.
- If two (2) cards are exposed during the deal, then the hand will be reshuffled and dealt over.
- Any person showing his cards to another player during the hand, will have their hand declared a dead hand, and they will be
 forced to forfeit that hand.
- If at any time after a played hand you show your cards to another player, you MUST show your hand to the remaining players at the table.
- There will be a one (1) minute time limit to make a betting decision. An additional 30 seconds may be requested. If you have not made the bet during this time frame your hand is dead.
- If player leaves their seat during a hand, it will be determined that he has folded his hand and has forfeited the pot.
- There will be short, five (5) minute breaks each hour. All tables will wait until all hands are completed and break will begin together. Once the timer has gone off, all players must rejoin their tables, as hands will be dealt within one (1) minute of this timer having gone off.
- The English-only rule will be enforced during this tournament at the poker tables.
- A player who wants to use a cellular phone must step away from the table.

A representative from Casino Entertainment will host and run this tournament. Disputed hands during the game will be decided by the *House Rules Committee*, which includes the tournament host(s). All rules are subject to change at the discretion of the House Rules Committee.
